




You will read the first three books listed here. I suggest you read *How to Read...* first. You can find a template for note-taking on Google Classroom (GC) for your use. Foster's book will help you with the next two. Then, read in whichever order you desire. Please keep a reader's journal IN A COMPOSITION NOTEBOOK for the two fiction pieces, using the prompts provided on GC. As you read, fill in the "AP Journal for Books/Plays" form found on GC. These are referred to as "Cheat Sheets" for the rest of the year. These books are yours to keep and you should treat them as such. That means annotating and writing in the books to help you locate passages, piece important ideas together, and help you gain a deeper understanding of the work. You may find the templates on GC.

This will help in referencing passages and in-class discussion. *The Kite Runner* has discussion questions at the back that I expect you will have explored on your own or with others in the class.
